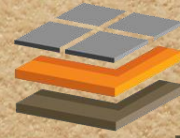

Carpet Installation

Choosing carpet, coordinating the installation, and preparing for your new carpet can seem overwhelming. However, Wilkerson Floors team is here to help with every step of the way to make the process easier than you think.

Removal & Disposal - Wilkerson Floors will remove and dispose of your old carpet and pad unless otherwise instructed by the client.

Temperature - Keeping the temperature of the home above 70 degrees helps the carpet relax and will allow for the installer to be more successful in stretching the carpet for a tight fit.

Furniture - We do ask the homeowner to move any valuable, breakable items or items of sentimental value prior to their installation date. Our team is glad to help move larger furniture to clear the space for installation.

We do not move gun safes, pianos, or other extremely large, heavy, or awkward items. We encourage you to connect with a moving company to have these items handled.

Furniture

It is a good idea to move heavy furniture from time to time even if only moving slightly to avoid excess compression of the carpet fiber. Rolling chairs should always have a hard mat under them to avoid damage from wheels.

Seams

Just as with any material, such as clothing, drapes, or upholstery, seams are visible. The level of visibility depends on multiple factors, including the number of seams, room lighting, and the carpet's material and thickness. Our experienced installers will do their best to place carpet seams in the most inconspicuous location in your space and, when possible, avoid direct lighting to help hide seams during your installation. Wilkerson Floors does not promise, imply, or guarantee that carpet seams will be invisible after installation. We guarantee that the seam will be properly installed to ensure a strong, lasting bond between the two sections of the carpet.

Cleaning

Regular vacuuming is necessary to prolong the life of your new carpeting and to keep your manufacturer's warranty in place. The frequency you should expect to vacuum varies depending on the amount of foot traffic and soil level your lifestyle introduces into the carpeted areas, once a week is a good starting point. Professional cleaning every 12-18 months is highly recommended and necessary for most warranties.

Entryways

These high-traffic areas not only get used frequently but are also where outdoor debris is introduced to your home. Using walk-off mats in these areas will not only protect this high-usage area of your floor but will help keep dirt, rocks, and general debris from spreading through the home.
